What is LinCC?

Hello! We are the Living in Care Council (LinCC, pronounced as link for short). We are a group of children in care and care leavers between the ages of 12-18. LinCC aims to be the link between those in care, care leavers and those in charge of our care. We meet up every two weeks on Thursdays to discuss how we can work with Bromley's workers to improve the level of care we receive. We meet with Elected Members and Senior Managers to discuss how we can work together to ensure that good services continue and to look at ways of improving other areas of being in care. Any young person in care 12 years and older or care leavers can join LinCC.



What we want to achieve

- We aim to have a total of 12 members.
- To meet with Councillors 6 times a year.
- To meet with managers 4 times a year.
- To have good communication methods in place with other children in care in Bromley.
- To listen to what children in care are saying about their experiences of being in care and communicating that to Councillors and Managers.
- To ensure that children in care are aware of the Bromley Pledge.
